Participant hereby assumes all Risks that might result from his/ her participation in any CAP IT Tampa event, social, ministry project or activity.

NON-REFUNDABLE TICKET POLICY

Tickets are NON-Refundable. **YOU MAY NOT SELL YOUR TICKET INDEPENDENTLY - EVEN TO OTHER CAP IT TAMPA MEMBERS!** Exchanges are permitted through CAP IT TAMPA ADMINISTRATION only - Up until 15 days prior to the event. Valid Attendees names and waivers must match and be turned in prior to the 15-day deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS!

DRESS CODE

Formal Attire Required

Ladies:

- Long, formal dresses or dressy pants suits* are permitted
- Strapless, 2-Piece (with small, 2-3" gap) dresses are permitted
- Attire must be conservative in nature (no plunging or revealing cleavage, and slits no higher than just above the knee)
- No above the knee dresses (high-low dresses must be approved)
- No dresses that expose cleavage
- No exposing the lower back (ie. dimples)

Gentlemen:

Tuxedo or formal dress coat/dress pants, dress shirt, dress shoes, bow tie or tie is expected for prom.

Everyone:

Neat, clean, dressier sneakers or boots are allowed

No Crocs/slides of any kind

No bathing suits or lingerie style clothing

No casual or dressy shorts

No jeans

No t-shirts

No baseball caps or casual hats

No costumes

No dressing as the opposite sex

NOTE: If your outfit does not meet our guidelines, you will be discreetly shown to a private space so we can come up with a solution for you to stay. Otherwise, you will be asked to leave, change, and return if you choose. There are NO refunds.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- There will be parental supervision and/or security during the entire event
- If you leave the venue before the event is over, you are not allowed back in without permission from a CAP IT committee member
- No outside food or drinks are allowed

You will be required to leave if you participate in "vulgar" booty dancing, cursing, rowdiness, fighting, vaping, or any behavior that we find disruptive to our event (see CAP IT's Code of Conduct below)

Cap It Tampa is committed to maintaining a safe, secure, and respectful environment that reflects the highest standards of our community and society. All students, parents, and others attending our sponsored events are expected to conduct themselves in a considerate and respectful manner and support a safe and respectful environment. Committee members, parent volunteers, and other volunteers must receive the respect their positions demand if they are to effectively perform their duties. Use of tobacco, vaping, alcohol, drugs, or offensive language and disrespectful or intimidating conduct directed toward a committee member, parent volunteer, or other volunteers will not be tolerated. Any such conduct by any student will result in an immediate request for the student to leave the function. A repeat offense will result in removal of the student from the Cap It Tampa group with no refund. For the enjoyment of ALL our attendees, there will be no "vulgar" booty dancing or inappropriate behavior allowed. If you leave the Venue before the event is over, you are not allowed back in for any reason. All attendees must stay within the designated event area. Students are not permitted to loiter outside the building for any reason. No outside food or drinks are allowed. CAP IT Tampa is not responsible for personal items and valuables left unattended. No offensive language or material is allowed as part of your attire. The Cap It Tampa Dress Code is strictly followed.

There will be NO exceptions and you will be turned away without a refund.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT

Participant authorizes and consents to any adult member involved in a social or event activity (hereafter “CAP IT Designee”) to administer general first aid treatment for any minor injuries or illnesses experienced by Participant. If the injury or illness is life threatening or in need of emergency treatment, Participant authorizes the CAP IT Designee to summon any and all professional emergency personnel to attend, transport and treat Participant and to issue consent for any X-ray, anesthetic blood transfusion, medication, or other medical diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care deemed advisable by, and to be rendered under the general supervision of any licensed physician, surgeon, dentist, hospital or other medical professional or institution duly licensed to practice in the state or country in which such treatment is to occur. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any such medical treatment and is given to provide authority and power on the part of the CAP IT Tampa Designee in the exercise of his or her best judgment upon the advice of any such medical or emergency personnel.

Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians assume personal responsibility of all medical bills and certifies that he/ she has secured primary medical insurance for him/ herself. Further, should it be necessary for the participant to return home due to medical reasons, for disciplinary action, or otherwise, Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians hereby assumes responsibility for all related transportation and / or communication costs.

RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In good and valuable consideration, including but not limited to Participant being allowed to participate in a social or event activity and the fullest extent permitted by law we, on behalf of ourselves, executors, administrators and Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians unconditionally agree to waive, release and hold harmless CAP IT Tampa, its officers, directors, and volunteers from any and all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action for personal injury, sickness, disease, death, damages to property and expenses of any nature (collectively “Claims”), incurred by us and/ or Participant, arising out of or related to in any way to a social or event activity, including negligence and/ or fault, in whole or in part, of the CAP IT Tampa Releases,. This PRE-INJURY WAIVER, RELEASES AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT applies to all Claims against CAP IT Tampa. This applies to all Claims. However, there is no obligation, express or implied, for CAP IT Tampa to procure insurance coverage to cover any potential Claim. CAP IT Tampa affirms that the safety and well-being of all participants is of utmost importance.

Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians have considered the ability to obtain independent insurance coverage and certify that we have secured primary medical insurance for the Participant or have other means to cover the expense of any loss, damage, or injury, as described above, and we accept the Risks and associated expenses.

To the extent any of the terms or provisions of this Activity Form is deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction or arbitration panel, then the terms or provisions that are deemed unenforceable shall be stricken and the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in force and effect to effectuate the intent of the parties for this form to be an enforceable non- commercial pre-injury release of a minor under Florida common law.

This form will be effective for participation in ONLY the CAP IT Tampa Activity for Prom on March 25, 2022 and any photographic and reprographic release made for Prom on March 25, 2022 and published anytime thereafter.

Participant's Parents/ Guardians acknowledge that they are the parents and/ or legal guardians of the Participant, have read and understood this Event and Activity Form in its entirety and have signed and delivered it voluntarily.

PHOTOGRAPHIC AND REPROGRAPHIC RELEASE

By Signing this document Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians hereby give CAP IT Tampa the absolute and irrevocable right and permission to use Participant’s name and to use, reproduce, edit, exhibit, project, display, copyright, publish photographic images and / or moving pictures and/ or videotaped images of Participant with or without Participant or Participant's Parents/ Guardians’ voice, or in which Participant may be included in whole or in

part, and therefore to circulate the same in all forms and media for art, advertising, trade, competition, or every descriptions and/ or any lawful purpose whatsoever. Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians also consent to the use of any printed matter, along with yearbook and programs, in conjunctions therewith, and waives any right to inspect and/ or approve the finished product(s) or the editorial, promotional or printed copy or soundtrack that may be used in connections therewith and any right that Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians may have to control the use to which said product(s), copy and or soundtrack may be applied. Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians discharge and agree to save and hold harmless CAP IT Tampa from any liability by virtue of any blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion or use in composite form whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur or to be produced in the making, processing duplication, projecting or displaying of said images, and from liability for violation of any personal or proprietary right that Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians may have in connection with said images and with the use thereof.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians agree that any claim or dispute arising from or related to this Activity Form shall be settled by person-to-person mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the Bible. All such mediation and arbitration shall take place in Hillsborough County, Florida. Judgment upon an arbitration award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction. The Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians understand that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or Claim arising out this Event Activity Form and Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit in any civil court against CAP IT Tampa, its officers, directors, volunteers for such disputes, except to enforce an arbitration decision. The Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians agree that the prevailing party in any dispute will be entitled to attorney's fees, costs and expense of litigation and that Participant and Participant's Parents/ Guardians will be responsible for such attorney's fees, costs and expense of litigation should CAP IT Tampa be deemed the prevailing party in any action. The Arbitrator(s) shall determine entitlement and amount of attorney's fees, costs, and expense of litigation.
