#### APPLICATION TYPES AND DEADLINES

| Decision Plan               | Priority<br>Application | Notification                   | Deposit Date                                     |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------|--------------------------------|--|
| Early Action                | November 1              | December 15                    | May 1  |
| Early Decision<br>(Binding) | November 1              | December 15                    | January 15<br>(non-refundable)                   |
| Regular Decision I          | December 1              | January 15                     | May 1  |
| Regular Decision            | March 1                 | April 1                        | May 1  |
| Rolling (After<br>March 1)  | Space available         | Within two weeks of completion | May 1, or within two weeks of receiving decision |

#### **EARLY ACTION**

Early action option is **nonbinding** and allows a student to apply earlier.

Receive an early response to your application!

**Application Date:** November 1

**Decision Notification Date:** December 15

Deposit Date: May 1



#### **EARLY DECISION**

**Early Decision** is **binding** and indicates your plan to enroll if accepted.

It's a great option for students who have done their research early and have already made the decision to attend your school of choice if admitted..

**Application Date:** November 1

**Decision Notification Date:** December 15

**Deposit Date:** January 15



## REGULAR DECISION OR PRIORITY DECISION

One singular main priority application deadline that is required to have your application released on a specific date.

#### **Example:**

FSU - October 15 UF - November 1

Apply and submit materials but a required date, you will receive your admissions decision on on date.

**Application Date:** November 1

**Decision Notification Date:** February 28

Deposit Date: May 1

- Receive your admissions decision earlier
- Begin receiving specialized communication
- Get a head start on your Next Steps
- Scholarship application deadlines
- Planning your campus visits





#### **DECISION RELEASE**

- Rolling
- Specific Date
  - December 15
  - January 15
  - April 1

Decisions are sent within 4-6 weeks from receipt of completed application at FSC.
