

CAP IT Tampa Dress Code - Homecoming

LADIES: Homecoming is a semi-formal event, and the expected attire for CAP IT ladies is CONSERVATIVE in nature.

- Dress length should be no higher than your fingertip when standing.
- No slits (front, back, or side) should be higher than your fingertip length in a standing position.
- Strapless permitted but must stay up and no cleavage showing.
- Two-piece dresses with less than 3 inches between top and bottom pieces are permitted.
- One piece dresses with cut-outs should show no more than 3 inches of skin at any given point.
- Your belly button should not be visible.
- Dresses that expose cleavage will not be permitted.
- Dress backlines should be kept close to the body with no gaps, and should be kept above the natural curve of the back.
- No lingerie or lingerie style clothing, bathing suits, shorts, jeans, t-shirts, graphic tees, baseball caps or costumes will be permitted. No offensive language or material is allowed as part of your attire.
- No flip flops, crocs, Birkenstocks permitted; dressy sneakers permitted.

GENTLEMEN: Homecoming is a semi-formal event, and the expected attire for CAP IT gentlemen is a dress shirt, tie and dress pants. Jackets are optional.

- Men's footwear: dress shoes; dressier sneakers are permitted as long as they are clean; no flip flops, sandals, or crocs.
- No bathing suits, shorts, jeans, t-shirts, graphic tees, baseball caps or costumes will be permitted. No offensive language or material is allowed as part of your attire.
